

Teen Programs, a key part of our Day Camp, are geared toward our teen campers who are ready for the next challenge. It is a progression from a more independent camper to real leadership and job responsibilities. All camp staff and volunteers are fully vaccinated for COVID 19.

- ❖ **Leader in Training (LIT):** 13- 14 years old with demonstrated maturity as a camper (12 year old turning 13 in 2024 will be considered) They will have more adventuresome field trips, hiking and camping and more group selected optional activities
- ❖ **Counselor In Training (CIT):** 14-15 year olds who are our future counselors ready for a program designed to provide them with those skills and will spend part of each day learning how to manage younger campers.
- ❖ **Counselor Assistants:** 15 year old with LIT or CIT program or comparable experience or 16 year olds without experience are eligible for volunteer or paid Counselor Assistant jobs.
- ❖ **Counselors / lifeguards / instructors:** 16 and older can apply for a variety of full and part time positions

❖ **TPDC** is a tax exempt not for profit community day camp in Haines Falls NY. We provide a caring and nurturing environment with age appropriate mixture of swimming, tennis, archery, games, sports, field trips, kayaking, crafts, yoga and music with a special emphasis on nature, hiking and overnight camping. Our Leaders In Training program adds more independent and adventurous activities. Supervision is provided by experienced adult educators and professionals supplemented with teen Counselors.

❖ **Summer of 2024** - We will be following local and NYS day camps health and safety procedures and will be communicating specific details with parents during the months prior to the start of Camp. TPDC requires that all campers and staff have age-appropriate vaccinations including COVID 19 aged 5 and older.

❖ **Our Campers and LIT's** are 3 to 14+ years old. All Campers and LITs must register for at least two weeks (except for Twilight Park campers and for house guests of longer-term campers).

❖ **Our Sessions** – Weekly sessions from July 1 to August 16. Full day is 9 am to 3 pm and half day is 9 am to 1 pm

Deposit - A non-refundable deposit of \$25 per camper per week is due at registration which begins Jan 1 2024

Refund Policy - Full refund (minus the non-refundable deposit) of camp fees if you cancel 2 weeks or less before the start of your child's camp.

Payments - Full payment is due 1 month before the start of camp. The camp accepts e-checks (ACH), credit cards (Mastercard & Visa) and check. Installment plans are available. A 3% service charge is applied to credit card payments.

Special Discount - Families with less than \$125,000 family income, or those with special circumstances may apply. These is a fixed amount of Special Discounts allocated for this year.
